

June 13, 2022

The regular meeting of the Thedford Public School Board of Education was called to order by President Licking at 7:30 p.m. at Thedford High School. Members present: Bridget Licking, Matt Blackford, Dixie Hoffman, Jay Jones, Steve Ahlstrom and Spencer Burk. Also present: Superintendent Dahlberg, recording secretary Angie Pettit and visitors.

Hoffman moved, Burk seconded to approve the agenda. Motion passed 6-0.

Jones moved, Hoffman seconded to approve the minutes of the May 16th regular board and April 19th budget amendment hearing meetings. Motion carried with a 6-0 vote.

Hoffman moved, Burk seconded to approve general expenditures totaling \$221,966.23 and motion passed 6-0.

Hoffman moved, Burk seconded to pay hot lunch expenditures of \$7,743.08 and motion passed 6-0.

Superintendent Dahlberg gave a superintendent report. He updated the board on school safety issues, upcoming changes in door and camera security, a threat assessment training and standard response protocol trainings. He presented the high school schedule and updated on the science position that remains open. He presented options for the KSB policy service and a clean bus rebate program. He went over the activity calendar for 2022-2023. He presented a letter from the Sandhills Cattle Association about the Steers for Students program.

Superintendent Dahlberg presented a report from the building committee meeting about school building plans. Discussion followed.

Terri Licking complimented the school and maintenance personnel on the BRAN event and reported on that.

Superintendent Dahlberg presented 2022-2023 handbooks for board approval. Discussion followed. Jones moved, Blackford seconded to approve the 2022-2023 Student/Parent Handbook and 2022-2023 Staff Handbook as presented. Motion passed 6-0.

Superintendent Dahlberg presented a quote from KC Electric to update the football field lights. Discussion followed. It was the consensus of the board to table this until next month.

Superintendent Dahlberg presented the recommendation of the building committee to the board for action. Discussion followed. Jones moved, Blackford seconded to authorize the building committee to proceed with scoping the project to include a cost analysis by an architect at one location as proposed. Motion carried 6-0.

President Licking adjourned the meeting at 9:15 p.m.
