## **SEPTEMBER 15, 2025**

The regular meeting of the Thedford Public Schools Board of Education was called to order by President Werner at 7:00 p.m. at Thedford High School. Members present: Alison Werner, Colton Schroeder, BJ Thomas, and Dixie Hoffman. Also present: Superintendent Dahlberg, Principal Kuntz, recording secretary Angie Pettit; NRCSA representative Jack Moles, teacher representative Staci Holthus and visitors. Board member Dan DeNaeyer arrived at 7:12 p.m.

Schroeder moved, Hoffman seconded to excuse absent board members DeNaeyer and Burk. Motion carried with a 4-0 vote. Absent: DeNaeyer and Burk.

Hoffman moved, Thomas seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried 4-0. Absent: DeNaeyer and Burk.

Jack Moles, NRCSA representative, made a presentation to the board on NRCSA and the services they provide to schools.

Thomas moved, Hoffman seconded to approve the minutes of the August 18<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. Motion passed 4-0. Absent: DeNaeyer and Burk.

Hoffman moved, Thomas seconded to approve general expenditures totaling \$360,335.54 and motion passed 4-0. Absent: DeNaeyer and Burk.

Thomas moved, Hoffman seconded to pay hot lunch expenditures of \$15,463.75 and motion carried with a 4-0 vote. Absent: DeNaeyer and Burk.

Hoffman moved, Schroeder seconded to approve all student finance invoices paid in the month of August for \$22,335.73. Motion passed 4-0. Absent: DeNaeyer and Burk.

There were no staff reports.

Principal Kuntz gave a Principal's report. He reported on the staff development training that was held and on the Knight Notes, which are encouraging messages students/staff can send to others. He also reported on meetings he has attended, teacher evaluations and walk throughs he is planning. State testing is also underway.

Superintendent Dahlberg gave an administrative report. He reported on the upcoming NASB conference in November. The audit is this Wednesday, the Beef in Schools flyer has been put together. He brought up the Booster Club donation for ideas, and reported on the money received from foundations, the upcoming special meeting to approve the budget on Monday, September 29<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m. and scheduling an American Civics committee meeting.

Staci Holthus reported that TeamMates is sponsoring a watch party of the Husker football game at the football field on Friday, October 17<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. Concessions will be available for sale.

The 2025-2026 budget was discussed.

Replacement vehicles were discussed.

The old business of assistance for Sandhills Area Daycare was tabled to the October meeting.
