

## **August 15, 2022**

The regular meeting of the Thedford Public School Board of Education was called to order by President Licking at 7:30 p.m. at Thedford High School. Members present: Bridget Licking, Matt Blackford, Steve Ahlstrom, Dixie Hoffman, Jay Jones and Spencer Burk. Also present: Superintendent Dahlberg, recording secretary Angie Pettit and visitors.

Hoffman moved, Burk seconded to approve the agenda. Motion passed 6-0.

Ahlstrom moved, Hoffman seconded to approve the minutes of the July 18<sup>th</sup> regular board meeting. Motion carried with a 6-0 vote.

Ahlstrom moved, Hoffman seconded to approve general expenditures totaling \$235,606.17 and motion passed 6-0.

Ahlstrom moved, Hoffman seconded to pay hot lunch expenditures of \$4,810.14 and motion passed 6-0.

There were no community presentations or staff reports.

Superintendent Dahlberg gave an administrative report. He reported on plans for science teaching, the budget update and hearing, building plans and setting up a building committee meeting, upcoming school events, the NASB legislative committee, NSCAS growth, and a reminder that this will be a negotiations year.

Superintendent Dahlberg reported on the Sports Co-op committee meeting. There will be handbook changes, changes in gate admissions (new prices are \$5 for adults, \$3 for students, \$40 for passes, but all S-T students will be free at both locations), getting information to junior high students and families, and filling some coaching positions.

There was no other public comment.

Superintendent Dahlberg presented Girls Wrestling for board approval. Hoffman moved, Ahlstrom seconded to approve the addition of Girls Wrestling to the Cooperative Activities Agreement. The motion carried 6-0.

Superintendent Dahlberg presented a Co-op Handbook for board approval. Discussion followed. Ahlstrom moved, Blackford seconded to approve the Co-op Handbook as presented. Motion passed 6-0.

Superintendent Dahlberg presented the hot lunch budget amendment for board approval. Discussion followed. Hoffman moved, Ahlstrom seconded to approve the amended budget as presented. Motion carried with a 6-0 vote.

President Licking adjourned the meeting at 8:24 p.m.
