

## CLASS RANKINGS AND GRADE POINT AVERAGE

The official grade point average (GPA) of graduating students is based on a minimum of 8 semesters of studies in order to allow students sufficient opportunity for demonstrating achievement. Temporary GPA's will be sent to colleges and universities who request information for admission.

The official GPA will be furnished to post-secondary institutions upon request. Both weighted and unweighted GPA's will be furnished as per request.

Students approved and who complete early graduation requirements will receive their official GPA based upon seven (7) completed semesters.

The district will name a Valedictorian based solely upon class rank and using any weighted grades that a student may have earned. The Valedictorian shall be the student earning the highest GPA using the weighted scale and having a minimum of six (6) semesters of enrollment in the district.
