JULY 19, 2023

The regular meeting of the Thedford Public School Board of Education was called to order by President Licking at 7:30 p.m. at Thedford High School. Members present: Bridget Licking, Jay Jones, Spencer Burk, Alison Werner, Dixie Hoffman and Matt Blackford. Also present: Superintendent Dahlberg, recording secretary Angie Pettit.

Blackford moved, Werner seconded to approve the agenda. Motion passed 6-0.

Hoffman moved, Burk seconded to approve the minutes of the June 19th board meeting. Motion carried with a 6-0 vote.

Werner moved, Blackford seconded to approve general expenditures totaling \$255,052.01 and motion passed 6-0.

Blackford moved, Werner seconded to pay hot lunch expenditures of \$1,185.50 and motion passed 6-0.

There were no community or staff reports.

Superintendent Dahlberg gave an administrative report. He reported on the budget for the upcoming school year, the policy manual and handbook update, gave an update on the new math teacher, an Emergency Operations Plan, and the Standard Response Protocol.

There was no public comment.

Superintendent Dahlberg presented a contract from Consumer Driven Technologies for IT services. Discussion followed. Werner moved, Burk seconded to approve the agreement with Consumer Driven Technologies for IT services as presented. Motion carried 6-0.

Superintendent Dahlberg presented job descriptions for board approval. Discussion followed. Jones moved, Hoffman seconded to approve the Thedford Public Schools job descriptions as presented. Motion carried with a 6-0 vote.

Superintendent Dahlberg presented updated school meal prices for board approval. Our school participates in the CEP where all student meals are free, but we still need to keep our prices current and milk prices in line with costs. Recommended prices are: (15 cent increases for all student meals; 30 cent increases for all adult meals): Student Breakfast: \$2.00, K-6 Lunch: \$3.05, 7-12 Lunch: \$3.25, Extra milk/snack milk: \$.50, Adult Breakfast: \$2.65, Adult Lunch: \$4.20. Discussion followed. Jones moved, Burk seconded to approve the 2023-2024 breakfast, lunch and meal prices as presented. Motion carried with a 6-0 vote.

President Licking adjourned the meeting at 8:34 p.m.
